Dear Ms. Miller:

I am sorry for the delay in writing this response to your letter of June 29th, but it was unavoidable.

I have reviewed your letter, with the attached vitae of Kurt W. Donsbach, and have consulted our academic records in order to make this response.

I will preface my remarks with the following statement by way of support of the facts: I have been very positively assured by the previous administration of Union University, that the University is presently in possession of any and all individuals who have been bona fide students and/or who have earned any degree or degrees, whatsoever. We choose to believe, having many reasons to do so, that our records are, therefore, complete and accurate.

I can, therefore, make the following statements concerning two points appearing in the aforementioned vitae of Mr. Donsbach: Union University, as an educational institution, has never had any person named Kurt W. Donsbach, as a student in any classes and in fact, have never had an application from such a person for admission to any academic program.

Furthermore, a thorough search of our records allows me to say that no person named Kurt W. Donsbach has ever earned any degree from Union University, at any level or in any discipline whatsoever.

I also add, as additional support for declaring, in regard to the specific degrees in Molecular Biology and Nutritional Science, that such degrees could not have been earned at Union University since the University has never, ever had the laboratories or other

necessary facilities, for any student to do work required to earn such degrees. One visit to our campus will more than prove this unquestionably to any observer.


If anything our facilities have been upgraded since 1975 and 1976, and our facilities, today, are woefully lacking in any scientific equipment and our facilities, in fact, may, by action of our Board of Trustees, be changed in favor of much better facilities, specifically because of their sad state of repair and limitations.

Therefore, in conclusion, I must make the following statement, for your records:

Kurt W. Donsbach has never been admitted as a student in Union University at any level, in any program; he has not earned an Master of Science in Molecular Biology degree in 1975, or any other year, from this University; he has not earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Nutritional Science degree in 1976, or any other year, from this University; he has not, in fact, ever been a bona fide student, in any department, at any time, at any level, in this University, and has never earned any degree in any discipline at any time.

I hope this letter is sufficient for your purposes.
